

HUNTING IN TAJIKISTAN



HUNTING SEASON

Second part of September - February

ROUTE

- Day 1 Arrival to Dushanbe. Transfer to Khorog (10–14 hours), stay overnight
- Day 2 Transfer from Khorog (6–8 hours) to the base camp, accommodation, rest
- Day 3-7 5-day hunting
- Day 8 Back to Khorog, stay overnight
- Day 9 Back to Dushanbe, stay overnight or flight home



HUNTING AREA

Tajikistan, Gorno-Badakhnskaya province, hunting camp “Hot Springs” (1) - (4.100 meter/ 13.500 feet altitude).



HUNTING

We organize the hunt at 13.100-15.000 feet (4.000-4.500 meters) altitude. During the hunt, we use Bigfoot 4x4 cars for transportation in the area. From the early morning, hunters and guides observe hillsides and sheep feeding areas. Once the trophy is located, we finish the hunt by stalking. Be ready for the long-range shooting, up to 450-750 yd (400-700m).

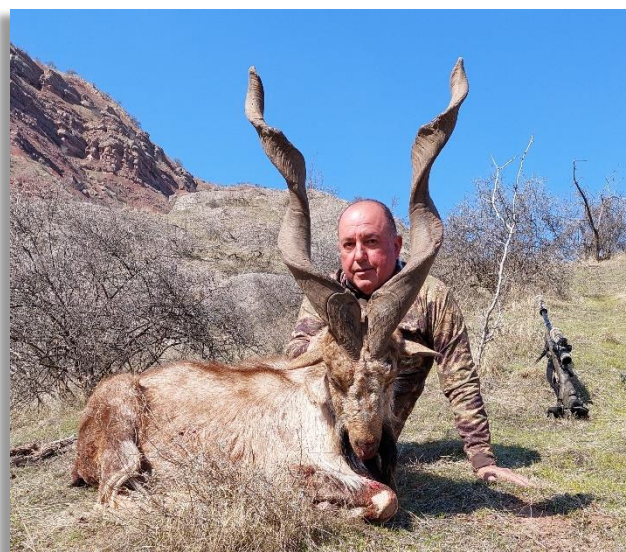


MARCO POLO ARGALI



MATISON ARGALI / BROOKEI ARGALI (Ovis ammon brookei)

International hunting clubs recognize the specie as separate one. Matison Argali horn bases are more massive than a Marco Polo argali and form a tighter spiral with little or no flare, and usually less than full curl. The tips are typically broken or heavily broomed.

ACCOMMODATION

A rather comfortable mountains hunting camp: living/dining room, thermal swimming pool, guesthouse for the hunters.



HUNTING RATES	
Outfitting, 5-day hunting, including 1 Marco Polo Argali	USD 43 500
Outfitting, 5-day hunting, including 1 Matisoni Argali	USD 48 500
Pamir Ibex trophy fees	USD 8 500
Non hunter fees	USD 5 500

Included: meet & greet at the airport; Stalker Group PH or interpreter per every group/camp; gun import permit; transportation to/from the hunting region and in the area; accommodation and meals in the camp during the hunt; local PH; trophy fee; all serving staff in the camp; trophy field care.

Extra costs: hunting license – USD 2 000 Argali, USD 1 200 Ibex (non-refundable and paid before the hunt), visa; international airfare; VIP-service in airport – USD 150 per entrance; hotel and meals in Dushanbe before and after the hunt; USD 1 600 per car - ground transfer Dushanbe-Khorog-Duschanbe; CITES; dip&pack; trophy shipment; tips.

Possibility of shooting and editing a professional film during the hunt.

\$4000 + cameraman's expenses for plane tickets and stay in the country.
