Measuring For Corner Windows

The Tools You'll Need



TAPE
MEASURE

STEP 1: Measure A¹

Measure from outside left edge of the left window to the corner.

Record measurement A¹ below.

STEP 2: Measure B¹

Measure how far you would like the rod to extend on the outside left side of the window. This space is where the left panel will “stack” when your drapery is fully opened.

Record measurement B¹ below.

STEP 3: Measure A²

Measure from outside right edge of the right window to the corner.

Record measurement A² below.

STEP 4: Measure B²

Measure how far you would like the rod to extend on the outside right side of the window. This space is where the right panel will “stack” when your drapery is fully opened.

Record measurement B² below.

STEP 5: Measure C

Measure the desired mounting height from the floor to the top of where your corner drapery rod will be mounted. You can do this from either window as the mounting height will be the same for both sides.

Record measurement C below.

**Please note, your mounting height must be at least 3½” above the top of the window trim to ensure there is enough room to mount the drapery rod brackets.*

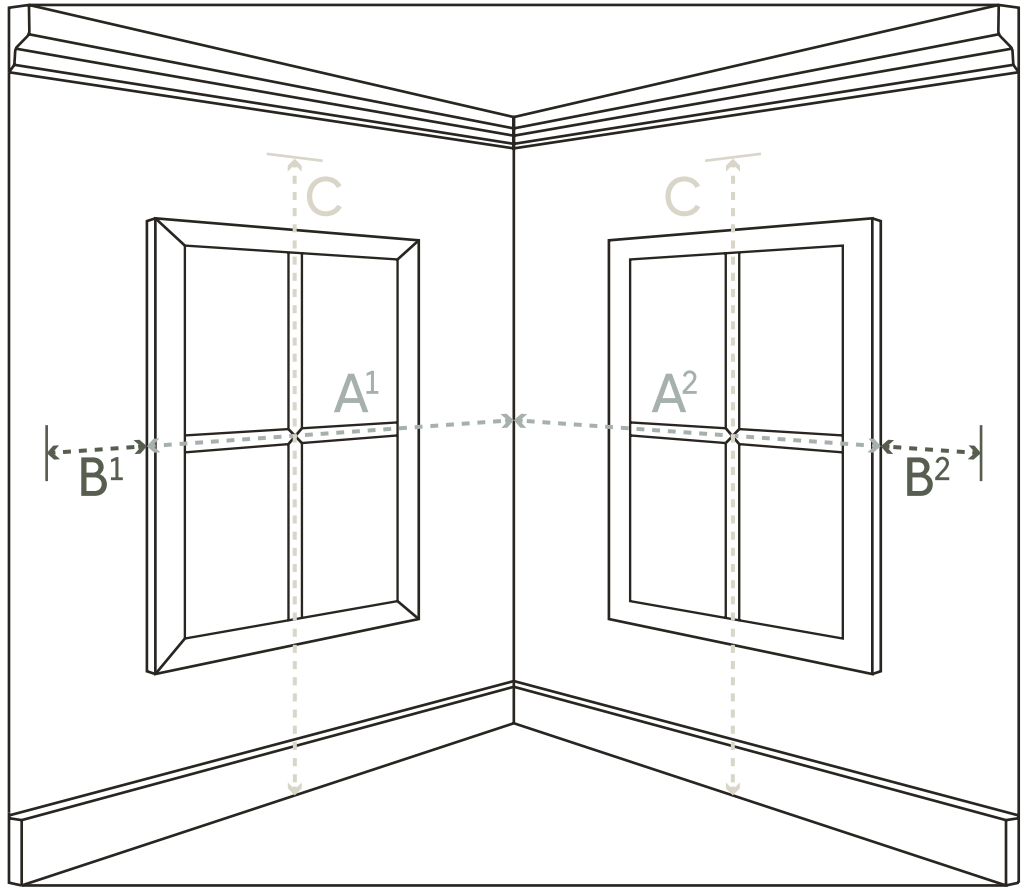

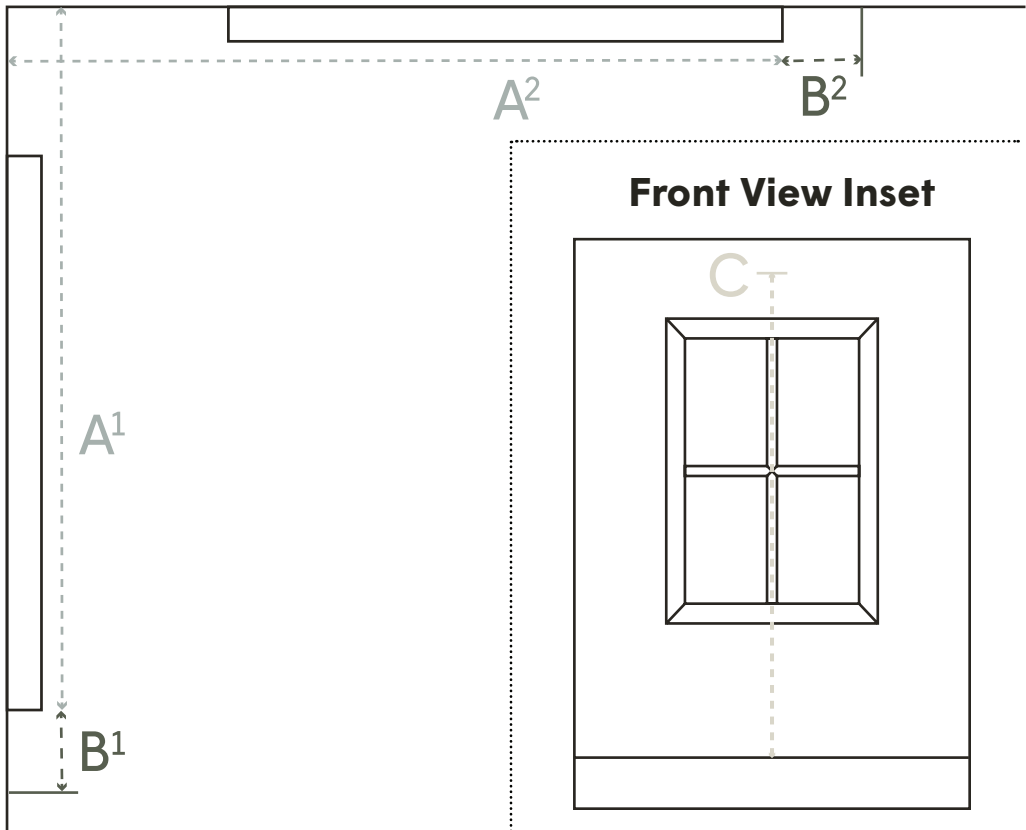
