


PROJECT SUMMARY

THE CHALLENGE:

Develop a safer method that allows the worker to access the tops of the plates without having to walk on top of them and still allow for access to all of the products without making it more difficult for the worker or hindering productivity.

Steel distribution centers sometimes store plate steel in material pits, arranged in a vertical orientation, by thickness and type of steel.

Physical size and weight of steel plates present material handling and safety challenges.

Ensuring worker safety and operational productivity while retrieving and moving this material presented an opportunity for LPI to design a custom "cat walk" style man lift.

Before the new moving catwalk was installed, workers precariously climbed on top of the oily steel plates with limited fall protection prying and separating the plates so that an overhead crane hook could lift the product.
