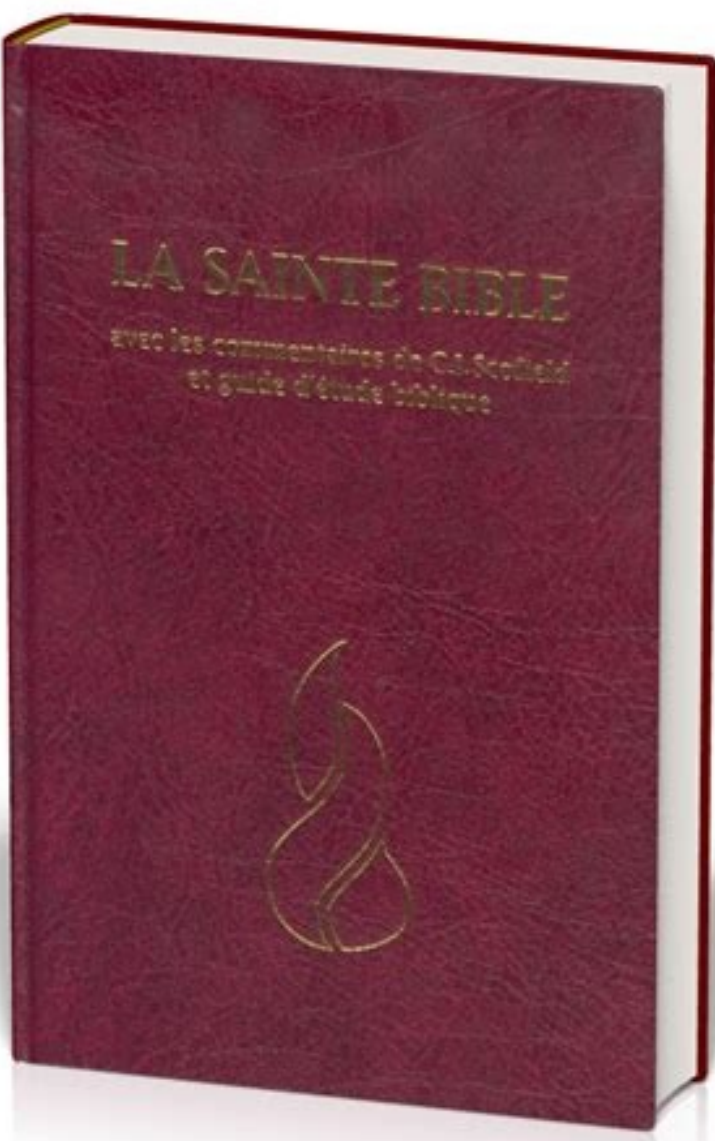


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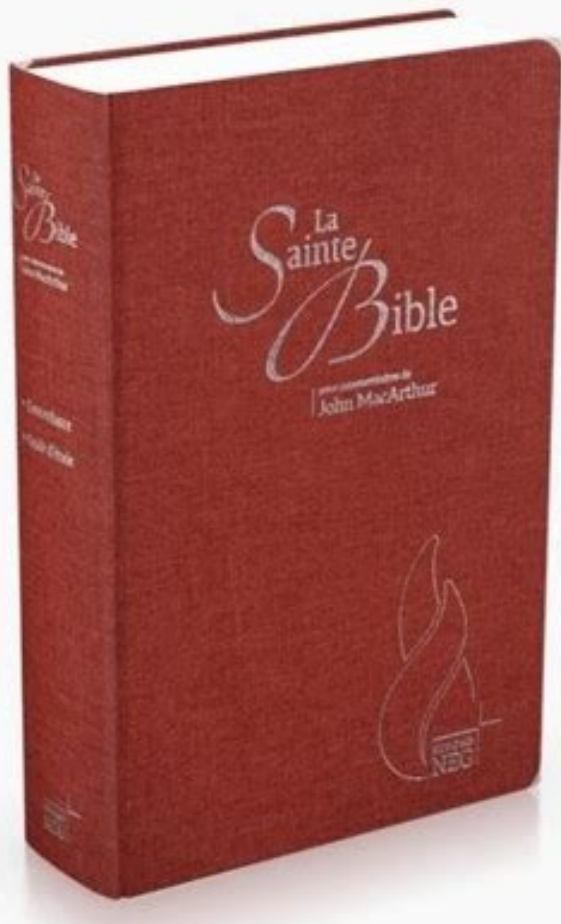
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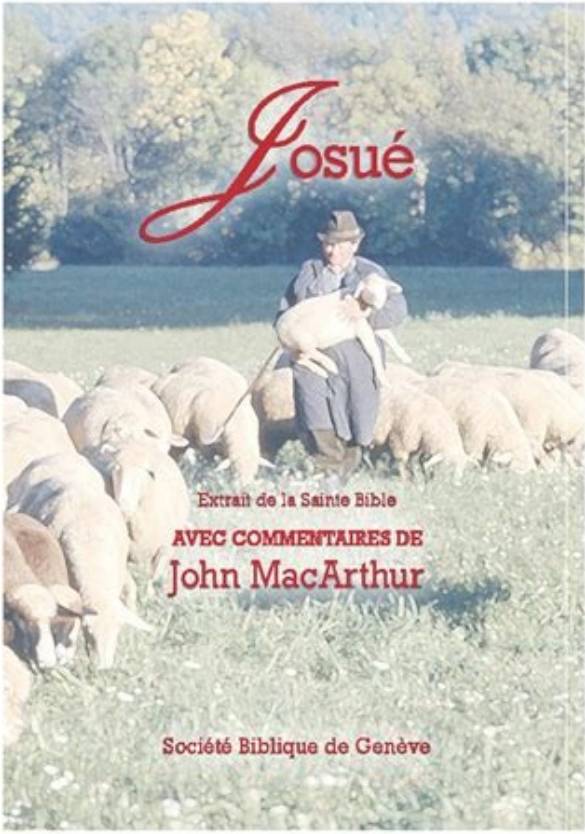

I can't believe I made it through all the prophets! I started with Genesis and read chronologically while also reading the New Testament chronologically. There is still way too much meaning in passages of the Bible that I haven't understood to say that I really truly READ everything there is to read here. But I have certainly absorbed all of it in some capacity.When I started, I scripture memorization seemed like a chore, but now it's one of my favorite things to do. When I started, I was going through a very difficult period of struggle with myself and my sin. Many things have changed since then. I was originally going to read it in a year, but then I encountered a snag during Isaiah and I slowed waaaay down. But somewhere in the middle of Isaiah, I figured out how to really READ poetry and enjoy it. This then allowed me to read the Psalms and find that they are my constant help in times of need. Poetry requires a certain baseline of experience to hear the richness of meaning in wordsthat I didn't have in my adolescence when I was originally made to read these things, and that explains why I never remembered any of it then.The book of Daniel is my favorite book in the Bible for OBVIOUS reasons. Even the prophetic visions at the end are incredible and I learned that the exact date of Jesus's Triumphal entry was predicted in verse 9:25. That entire section still blows my mind.Our world needs more Old Testament. The Pentateuch is the foundation of the work of Christ, who obeyed the entire Law and then provided the atonement for mankind by dying and rising again on the third day. We simply don't understand what it means that Israel for thousands of years performed bloody sacrifices which demonstrated the atonement for sins. The meaning of it was in the actions they carried out DAILY. Leviticus ain't boring folks. The world has no excuse but to believe in His name. The riches of the revelation of God are sufficient to bring the whole world to salvation, but only those who trust into the name of Jesus will be saved. His work is finished and reliable, but who will place their burdens on Him instead of relying on their own performance? All we like sheep have gone astray, and each of us has turned to his own way, and the Lord has laid on HIM the iniquity of us all. Who cannot receive this gift of grace? Who cannot rely on it day after day and walk in increasing obedience and joy, even in the midst of suffering?
