Poetry requires a certain baseline of experience to hear the richness of meaning in wordsthat I didn't have in my adolescence when I was originally made to read these things, and that explains why I never remembered any of it then. The book of Daniel is my favorite book in the Bible for OBVIOUS reasons. Even the prophetic visions at the end are incredible and I learned that the exact date of Jesus's Triumphal entry was predicted in verse 9:25. That entire section still blows my mind. Our world needs more Old Testament. The Pentateuch is the foundation of the work of Christ, who obeyed the entire Law and then provided the atonement for mankind by dying and rising again on the third day. We simply don't understand what it means that Israel for thousands of years performed bloody sacrifices which demonstrated the atonement for sins.
