A SUSTAINABLE VISION OF TRAVEL

Alto travel trailers are ultralight and have an extremely low drag coefficient. They can be towed using vehicles with a smaller engine capacity, which reduces non-renewable energy consumption. We also use sustainable and recyclable materials, minimize manufacturing waste and offer eco-friendly equipment options like solar panels. With your help, we want to be part of the solution.

Our primary objective is to allow everyone to keep traveling in a more sustainable way-now and for many years to come.



OUR MATERIALS

An Alto's roof and walls (1) are manufactured from a sandwich-type material. It is composed of a plastic honeycomb core laminated with aluminum on one side and AluFiber or aluminum on the other. AluFiber combines the lightness of aluminum with the durability of fiberglass. What's more, Alto trailers are made using only materials on which water has little effect, like aluminum, AluFiber, plastic, Formica and glass.


On the inside, the trailer's furnishings (2) are manufactured mainly from aluminum and composite materials. Ultralight, rigid sandwich panels are integrated into the bed cushions, and the bed frames (3) are made entirely from aluminum extrusions.

UNDERNEATH THE ALTO

Alto travel trailers boast excellent stability thanks to an independent Flexiride suspension (4) and a super-low centre of gravity. The floor and frame (5) are made from aluminum. For optimized aerodynamics, the frame is weld-free and supports streamlined tanks. What's more, powerful electric brakes (6) come standard on all Alto models.

ROOF AND FORM ➤ The Alto offers two roof options: retractable or fixed. Both are designed to prevent water infiltration and optimize the trailer's aerodynamics. The retractable roof on our R-series trailers is great for storing your Alto in a garage. It also offers exceptional sunlight thanks to its crescent-shaped glass windows (7). Alternatively, the fixed roof on our F- and A-series models provides optimal overhead space. This allows for spacious storage that's easy to access, as well as a comfortable shower and toilet layout.




OUR MAKERS





FUNCTIONAL APPROACH ➤ Thanks to a retractable roof, R-series Alto models can fit in most residential garages. When the roof is open, our trailers offer a very comfortable indoor space with an interior height of 82 inches (2.08 m). The front dining area can be used even when the rear bed is deployed. The beds, fridge, toilet and storage are accessible when the roof is down. What's more, you can create two separate dining areas by moving the table. An interior shower option (model R1723) is also available.

RETRACTABLE ROOF ➤ The roof's surface is made from a single, joint-free piece of

aluminum, and its mechanism is powered by electric linear actuators. When the roof is lowered, the Alto's drag coefficient is 75% lower. This is thanks to its aerodynamic shape, which was developed in a virtual wind tunnel. This factor, alongside the trailer's lightness, makes the Alto ideal for towing with most compact cars and small SUVs.



EUROPEAN FLAIR

Imported from Europe, the pano-

ramic windows in the F series have double-glazed acrylic panes, making them impressively light and providing enhanced insulation. Equipped with a combined blind/

screen system, these windows open so wide, you'll almost feel like you're outside. The front dining area has a

huge, curved window and can be used when the rear bed is deployed. By moving the table, you can create

two separate dining areas.



MORE ALTO TO LOVE ➤ Keeping the same materials and the same large windows as the F17 series, the F21 series offers a more spacious interior and more generous storage. Designed to fit 4 people comfortably, this series includes both king and queen size beds, larger water and propane tanks, a roomier fridge and a more powerful combined heater/water heater system. The 4-seater front dining area has kept its huge curved window, and remains usable even when the rear bed is deployed. Furthermore, the table can be moved and attached to the side of the trailer to create an exterior dining area.
