To focus on during levelling: Level 1-40: Strength > Spirit > Agility > Stamina > Intellect Level 40-60: Agility > Strength > Stamina > Spirit > Intellect The best build for levelling is from Level 10-40, providing excellent health regeneration in combat. This changes at Level 40 when Arms gets more out of Cleave. Prioritise these talents: Cruelty (5/5), Booming Voice (5/5), Blood Craze (3/3), Piercing Howl (1/1), Improved Battle Shout (1/5), Enrage (5/5), Death Wish (1/1), Flurry (5/5), Bloodthirst (1/1) From Level 40 onwards, strongly recommend this build due to Mortal Strike's importance in Arms spec. (15+) given by Wilder Thistlenettle in Stormwind Ancient War Sword, a quest reward from Defeat Nek'rosh (Level 23+), given by Dragonmaw Catapult in Wetlands Corpsemaker, dropped by Overlord Ramtusk in Razorfen Kraul Whirlwind Axe, a reward from the Warrior quest Whirlwind Weapon (Level 30+) Bonebiter, a quest reward from In the Name of the Light (Level 34+), taking place in Scarlet Monastery Horde Large Axe or Wooden Mallet, depending on your primary weapon skill, sold by any Weapons Vendor at Level 3, regardless of starting area Axe of Orgrimmar, a quest reward from Hidden Enemies (Level 9+), given by Thrall in Orgrimmar Demolition Hammer, a quest reward from Weapons of Choice (Level 17+), given by Tatternack Steelforge in The Barrens Orcs are strong in PvE and PvP due to their racials Blood Fury and Axe Specialisation. Humans have Mace and Sword Specialisation, which work well for grinding reputation and PvP.
