Currently, 40 technical schools offer diploma programs in pharmacy. Pharmacy is a scientific profession that prepares, dispenses, and uses medication appropriately to achieve optimal therapeutic outcomes. The pharmaceutical industry and healthcare services rely on pharmacists for quality control and drug management. The Nepal Pharmacy Council (NPC) ensures the quality of pharmacy education through approved degrees, including Diploma in Pharmacy (Pharmacy Assistant level). The NPC Guidelines for Accreditation of Pharmacy Degree Programmes (2003) and Norms for Establishment of New Pharmacy Degree College (2004) ensure that students receive the necessary education for professional registration. To join this program, students must complete 10 years of formal schooling with a minimum aggregate result of 45%. The Diploma in Pharmacy is a three-year course after SEE. The medium of instruction is English and/or Nepali. The program duration is three academic years, with a minimum attendance requirement of 80%. The grading system includes Pass division (below 60%), Second division (60% to below 65%), First division (65% to below 80%), and Distinction (80% or above). To be awarded the "Diploma in Pharmacy" certificate, students must meet CTEVT's requirements, including passing entrance examination and submitting necessary documents. Applicants must submit SLC pass certificate, character certificate, citizenship certificate, medical fitness certificate, and other required documents at the time of application. **Admission Details and Fees** Note: The student quota for different categories of students is based on the policies of Nepal Pharmacy Council and CTEVT.
