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Activation of Serial Number and EDIUS ID Required to Use EDIUS To use EDIUS, serial number and EDIUS ID activation is necessary. If serial number or EDIUS ID is not activated, it cannot be used. **###** Activating Serial Number To activate serial number: 1) Double-click the EDIUS icon on desktop to display entry screen. 2) Activate serial number according to on-screen instructions. 3) Enter 6-digit character string in left field and 16-digit character string in right field for serial number. Note that serial number cannot be reissued. **###** Activating EDIUS ID To activate EDIUS ID: 1) Activate EDIUS ID according to on-screen instructions. 2) Once EDIUS ID is correctly activated, serial number and EDIUS ID are linked, and EDIUS is started. If EDIUS ID is not registered, click [Create EDIUS ID] to register. **###** Online Registration To get online serial number registration: 1) Double-click the EDIUS icon on desktop during first launch. 2) Input serial number according to on-screen instructions. 3) Note that serial number cannot be reissued and must be kept securely. 1. Click on Windows logo at lower left of start screen to display start menu and click Grass Valley then GV LicenseManager. 2. Right-click GV LicenseManager icon in task bar and click License List or double-click icon. 3. [Online activation] Register serial number for EDIUS online activation. 4. [Online deactivation] Return licenses on EDIUS terminal in online environment to activation server. 5. [Offline Activation Create ID File] Create ID file to activate licenses on EDIUS terminal in offline environment. 6. [Offline Activation Register Activation File] Register license activation file acquired from activation server to EDIUS terminal in offline environment. 7. [Offline Deactivation Create ID File] Create ID file to deactivate licenses on EDIUS terminal in offline environment. 8. [Offline Deactivation Register Activation File] Register license deactivation file acquired from activation server to EDIUS terminal in offline environment. 9. [Online Repair] This item is not available. 10. [Offline Repair Create ID File] This item is not available. 11. [Offline Repair Register Repair File] This item is not available. 12. Click Settings for various settings. 13. Use floating license server to check this item and enter Server address and Port number. 14. Show License Expiration Warning to set timing to display warning message. 15. Administrator Password to restrict license activation/deactivation operations. 16. Confirm part of serial number in License List dialog box by right-clicking product and clicking Confirm part of serial number. To transfer a license using a USB memory device, follow these steps: First, deactivate the license by connecting the USB device to a PC with no internet connection, then click "Offline Deactivation Create ID File". Select the USB as the export destination and click "OK". Disconnect and reconnect the USB to another PC connected to the internet. Double-click GVDeactivation.exe and confirm deactivation. Alternatively, if you need to register your serial number on a new EDIUS PC, start GV LicenseManager and click "Offline Activation Create ID File". Enter your serial number, select the USB as the export destination, and click "OK". Disconnect and reconnect the USB to another PC connected to the internet. Double-click GVActivation.exe and confirm activation. To create a system report, click on the "Create System Report" option in the dialog box. This will allow you to save the file and set the destination for creating the report. Alternatively, you can also access this feature from the Windows start menu by opening EDIUS System Reporter. If you're having trouble activating your EDIUS or Mync license manually, there are steps you can take. First, ensure that you have a valid serial number. For most versions of EDIUS (later than 6.5), including Elite and Neo 3.5, as well as all option licenses like Mync, XRE Server, and XRE Transcoder, the process is similar. Typically, license activation occurs when you first start using EDIUS or Mync. However, if this fails or you need to activate an additional license (such as an option license), you'll need to use the GV License Manager instead. To do this, follow these steps: 1. Access the GV License Manager from the notification tray at the bottom right of your desktop. 2. Click on the "Online Activation" button within the License List context menu. 3. Enter your serial number and click OK. If you have an Upgrade or Jump Upgrade license, you'll be prompted to enter the serial number for the earlier version of EDIUS. 4. The online activation process will then proceed. 5. Once activated, your license will be listed in the GV License Manager. Click on the "X" button to close the list. 6. Finally, run the activated product. If you're prompted to log in with an eID and password, simply enter them and click Log in. Remember that if you've activated a Jump Upgrade or Upgrade license, don't deactivate your earlier version of EDIUS. Both licenses must be listed for everything to function properly.
