Nda college nationals 2025 results

More than 10,000 college cheerleaders and dancers gathered at Daytona Beach Bandshell last week to compete for a national title. Over 470 teams from across the U.S. participated in the National Champion event, with each team judged on their stunting skills, crowd-leading ability, and overall performance. The dance teams were evaluated on choreography, technique, execution, and effect. The College Game Day divisions have seen significant growth since its debut in 2017, allowing teams to compete alongside their school's band. This division has become a fan favorite, showcasing collegiate pride and school spirit. Varsity Spirit President Bill Seely noted that the event continues to be a defining moment for collegiate athletes nationwide, celebrating thousands of athletes' energy, passion, and dedication. The winners in various divisions included: Advanced Large Coed DIA at Texas Tech University, Adv. All-Girl DIA at the University of Louisville, Game Day DIA at Brigham Young University, Jazz DIA at Syracuse University, Hip Hop DIA at the University of Colorado Boulder, Pom DIA at Iowa State University, and more. The top teams in each division will be announced on Varsity TV's website. Varsity Spirit and Varsity Brands Host the National Dance Association's College National Championships, Celebrating Spirit and Student Achievements. The 2025 NCA & NDA Collegiate Cheer and Dance Championship has concluded, drawing over 10,000 athletes from more than 470 college programs to the Daytona Beach Bandshell. The event saw a range of performances across various divisions, with DI, DII, DIII, and Junior College teams showcasing impressive routines filled with complex stunts, synchronization, and crowd engagement. Top-performing schools included Weber State University, which collected multiple major titles, and Oklahoma Baptist University, which secured the Advanced All-Girl DII championship title. Junior Colleges also made a strong impact, with Navarro College and Trinity Valley Community College claiming coed titles, while Blinn College won both All-Girl and Pom divisions. The 2025 NCA & NDA Collegiate Grand Champions have been announced, with Weber State University and the University of West Georgia showcasing exceptional stunt execution. The Large Coed Grand Champion title was awarded to Weber State University, while the Small Coed Grand Champion title also went to Weber State University. Oklahoma Baptist University took home the All-Girl Grand Champion title, and Iowa State University won the Pom Grand Champion title. Alma College was named the Hip Hop Grand Champion. Select Division Champions included Texas Tech University, University of Louisville, and Brigham Young University. The event was live-streamed on Varsity TV, allowing fans to watch routines and team interviews in real-time. This year's championship saw one of the largest participations to date, solidifying Daytona's position as a benchmark for college cheer and dance excellence. The 2025 NDA College Nationals will begin on April 10, with hundreds of teams competing for national titles across various divisions, including jazz, hip hop, pom, and team performance. Fans can follow the competition live on Varsity TV, with exclusive coverage and real-time updates throughout the weekend.
