## How to program my viper 2 way remote

**Viper 2 way remote programming. How to pair viper alarm remote. How to pair viper remote start to phone. How to pair a viper remote. How to pair viper 1-way remote.**

For those using Viper 2-way remotes, here's how to program specific features. On the back is a P button; press and hold for two seconds to enter programming mode, indicated by a long beep. To exit, either press and hold again or wait 20 seconds. The arm button toggles vibrate mode, useful for silencing confirmation noises. The disarm button controls the backlight, handy in low-light situations. The Viper car alarm system uses a four-button transmitter for locking/unlocking doors and remote ignition. If your transmitter is lost or damaged, you can purchase a replacement. Before using a new remote, program it by following these steps: Plug the "Valet/Program" switch into the blue port on the housing. Open the door and turn the ignition key to the "On" position. Press the switch once (for systems with remote start) or seven times (without remote start) within five seconds of turning the ignition. Hold the button down for the final press, which will trigger a LED flash and horn chirp on the remote. Next, press the desired transmitter button to assign it to a channel. The horn will chirp again. Release the switch and turn off the ignition.
