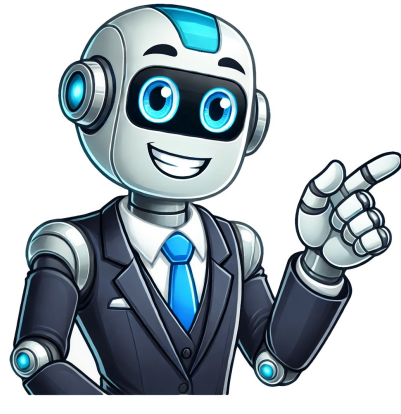


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Metro north train schedule harlem line

Metro-North provides transportation to customers in New York and Connecticut via its Harlem, Hudson, New Haven, Port Jervis, and Pascack Valley lines. The service offers unique perspectives on NYC attractions through Insiders Events View. Additionally, exclusive tours are available at the renovated Frick Collection and a showcase of works from renowned students and teachers at the League's 150th anniversary event. The Metro-North Commuter Railroad operates with five separate lines and 124 stations across New York City, the Hudson Valley, and Connecticut, serving over 300,000 daily commuters. It is one of the busiest commuter railroads in North America. The current system has its roots in three historical train systems: New York Central, Harlem, and Hartford. The MTA took control in 1983, rebranding as Metro-North.The service extends beyond trains, with a bus network and ferry lines connecting commuters to various parts of the region. Ferries from Haverstraw-Ossining and Newburgh-Beacon help connect west side commuters with east side Metro-North trains. Despite its size, there are several unknown secrets about Metro-North, including the hidden power station M42 beneath Grand Central Terminal, which remains largely unacknowledged until recent years.The underground world of Grand Central Terminal is shrouded in mystery, with secrets that remain unexposed to this day. The M42 basement, a highly classified area, was once a target for German spies aiming to disrupt rail movements on the East Coast. However, contemporary evidence suggests that Grand Central itself was not directly targeted.According to writer Sam Roberts, Grand Central could have been a potential target, but there is no concrete proof. Conversely, documents from MI5 and personal accounts by spy ring members do not mention it as a target.Today, the original rotary converters have been replaced, with one preserved for historical significance. In 2016, we had the opportunity to visit the M42 basement during a behind-the-scenes tour of Grand Central.Another lesser-known aspect of Grand Central is the Metro-North Operations Control Center, which resembles a NASA control room and functions similarly to air traffic control. This center is staffed 24/7, managing commuter trains, Amtrak trains, freight trains, and maintenance trains on the Metro-North tracks.The operations team, known as Rail Traffic Controllers, coordinate train traffic and handle emergency requests. The facility remains off-limits to many employees due to its sensitive nature.Lastly, some Metro-North tracks are named after food companies or defunct stations, adding a touch of nostalgia to the railroad's history. The Dog Food Siding Track in Hillburn, NY, is one such example, although it is currently inactive and no longer serves as a delivery point for dog food.In an interesting twist, some sidings were once named after real train companies or products that were once in demand, providing a glimpse into the railroad's past. The Jungle Tiki Bar Car was another unique feature on Metro-North trains before its eventual discontinuation.The Metro-North bar car was a unique feature that allowed passengers to enjoy drinks while on board. The tiki-themed decor, complete with custom decals and bamboo poles, created a festive atmosphere. However, the bar car's design also led to issues with insects and inebriated commuters.Metro-North has a safety program called TRACKS, which includes a superhero named Metro-Man who educates school kids on railroad safety and provides masks at Grand Central Terminal.The Metro-North Lost and Found is responsible for collecting over 20,000 items left behind on trains every year. To recover lost items, passengers must complete an electronic form and follow a multistep process. The Lost and Found has seen an increase in "contactless recovery" using FedEx during the pandemic.Additionally, there is a previously unknown track at Grand Central Terminal known as Track 61, which was built for freight and has been largely abandoned.The iconic Grand Central Terminal boasts an impressive underground infrastructure, including its massive basement that spans 49 acres from 42nd to 97th street, making it New York City's largest basement. Despite various myths surrounding FDR's personal train car, a recent investigation by Untapped New York has debunked claims that the long-abandoned train car on Track 61 was in fact used by Roosevelt. Meanwhile, a new project aims to bring Long Island Rail Road trains into the terminal via the East Side Access Project, which will feature the deepest train tunnels on Earth, sitting 90 feet below the Metro-North tracks.The MTA's canine explosives detection force is also patrolling the area, consisting of highly trained German Shepherds and Belgian Malinois mixes. These dogs undergo a rigorous 20-week training program in Cooperstown, New York, before serving for an average of 8-10 years. The 125th Street Station in Harlem has undergone a remarkable restoration process, with its original structure having been replaced by a replica built between 1993 and 1999.Great attention to detail was given when restoring the Metro-North station, incorporating elements from its original construction era such as paint samples and solid oak paneling, resulting in a station that appears suspended in time. The efforts put forth have created a unique blend of past and present. Additionally, plans are underway to expand the Metro-North system by adding four new stations in the Bronx, connecting underserved communities to the MTA network. The proposed rail line would span across the East River via the Hell Gate Bridge, extending its final destination at Grand Central to Penn Station. The show was produced by Jesse Collins Entertainment, directed by Alex Rudzinski, and broadcast on ABC in the United States. Eugene Levy and Dan Levy co-hosted the event. In the main ceremony, Baby Reindeer, The Bear, and Shgun tied for most wins with four each, including Outstanding Limited or Anthology Series for Baby Reindeer and Outstanding Drama Series for Shgun. Other winners were Hacks with three awards, and Alex Edelman: Just for Us, The Crown, The Daily Show, Fargo, Last Week Tonight with John Oliver, The Morning Show, Ripley, Slow Horses, The Traitors, and True Detective: Night Country each took home one award. Shgun led all programs with 18 wins, a record for a show in one year; FX had the most network wins with 36 total awards. Jeremy Allen White won Outstanding Lead Actor in a Comedy Series, Jean Smart won Outstanding Lead Actress in a Comedy Series, and Hiroyuki Sanada won Outstanding Lead Actor in a Drama Series.The Bear triumphed in becoming the most awarded program for a single year in Emmy history by winning an impressive 18 awards, surpassing the previous record of 13 set by John Adams in 2008. It also broke Game of Thrones' record of 12 wins in consecutive years from 2015 to 2019. The show set another record within itself by achieving 11 wins for a comedy series in a single year. Notably, Japanese actors Hiroyuki Sanada and Anna Sawai made history as the first performers from their country to win Outstanding Lead Actor in a Drama Series and Outstanding Lead Actress in a Drama Series, respectively. The awards were presented to various individuals and programs for their outstanding work in television, film, and other creative fields.At the recent Television Academy ceremony, several awards were handed out to various networks and individuals. **Network Nominations Breakdown**The totals reveal that FX had a strong showing with 107 nominations, followed closely by Netflix with 93 nods. HBO / Max trailed behind with 70 nominations. Apple TV+ received 38 nods, while ABC garnered 2 nominations. Other notable mentions include Disney+, Peacock, and Hulu.The ceremony featured numerous presenters who introduced awards or segments throughout the event. **Presenters at the Ceremony** Notable presenters included Steve Martin, Selena Gomez, Colin Farrell, George Lopez, Damon Wayans, Jesse Tyler Ferguson, Kaitlin Olson, Rob McElhenney, Da'Vine Joy Randolph, Candice Bergen, Padma Lakshmi, and Sam Richardson.Tributes were paid to various TV-related themes throughout the ceremony. **Tribute Segments** These included tributes to TV dads, presented by George Lopez, Damon Wayans, and Jesse Tyler Ferguson; TV villains, presented by Kathy Bates, Antony Starr, and Giancarlo Esposito; and TV moms, presented by Meredith Baxter, Connie Britton, and Susan Kelechi Watson.The 76th Primetime Emmy Awards took place on September 15, 2024, with a four-year rotation deal among the "Big Four" broadcast networks. The ceremony was produced by Jesse Collins Entertainment and featured co-hosts Eugene Levy and his son Dan for the first time. The event marked the second Primetime Emmy Awards ceremony held in 2024 due to the rescheduled 75th ceremony. ABC broadcast the gala as part of their rotation deal, with the corresponding Creative Arts ceremonies airing on September 7 and 8. The ceremony included tributes to TV lawyers, The West Wing, Happy Days, and Saturday Night Live, as well as reunions in honor of the awards' nominees. It was made available for streaming on Hulu following the event.The 2024 Creative Arts Emmy Awards were held in July, featuring a new format and presenting several awards. The ceremony received mixed reviews from critics, with some praising the hosts' efforts while others criticized production elements. Some reviewers found the ceremony to be less dynamic than previous years, citing issues with sound quality and presenter grouping. Ben Travers noted that the hosts, Eugene Levy and Dan Levy, lacked enthusiasm, but praised certain presenters like Candice Bergen and Billy Crystal. Lili Loofbourow also expressed disappointment with the hosts' forgettable performance. On the other hand, Judy Berman complimented the Levys for bringing lighthearted moments to the ceremony without overdoing it. Daniel Fienberg considered the show "above-average," praising surprise winners and impressive speeches. Robert Lloyd described the telecast as a "sweet" and positive event that avoided self-congratulation. The ceremony drew 6.9 million viewers in the US, surpassing previous years by 54%. It achieved a strong rating among adults aged 18-49.The 76th Primetime Emmy Awards nominations list features a diverse ensemble of talent, including executives, writers, performers, producers, and more.Former Star Trek: The Next Generation star Patrick Stewart was honored as Outstanding Supporting Actor in a Drama Series for his portrayal of a senator in the film "American Dreams/Fall from Grace." The ceremony was held in September 2024, as announced by ABC earlier in the year. According to reports from The Hollywood Reporter, Variety, and TheWrap, the Emmys returned to their traditional Sunday night time slot. The event was produced by Jesse Collins Entertainment, with Eugene and Dan Levy serving as co-hosts, making history as the first father-and-son duo to host the awards. The production team included a full lineup of professionals, and Robin Roberts hosted the Emmy Primetime Special and Red Carpet Live Pre-Show. Viewers could watch the ceremony live on TV or stream it online, with options available for free on ABC. The event also featured tributes to iconic shows such as SNL and Happy Days, as teased by the Emmys EPs.The Emmys, hosted by Eugene and Dan Levy, featured a reunion of Saturday Night Live (SNL) cast members, with the producers highlighting the chemistry between the duo. The ceremony aimed to lean into nostalgia, with some critics praising the light-hearted tone. However, others found the show to be somewhat humdrum due to sparse crowds and sponsored content.The Emmys received mixed reviews, with some critics noting that it felt like a rerun. Despite this, the event still managed to attract an audience of nearly 6.9 million viewers, its highest in three years. The ceremony also included an "In Memoriam" segment, which honored late TV luminaries, and Jimmy Kimmel paid tribute to Bob Newhart.The Academy of Television Arts & Sciences website provided information on the Emmy nominating ballots for programs, performers, directing, and writing.The list of shows and individuals that linked to the 76th Primetime Emmy Awards page is presented here.
