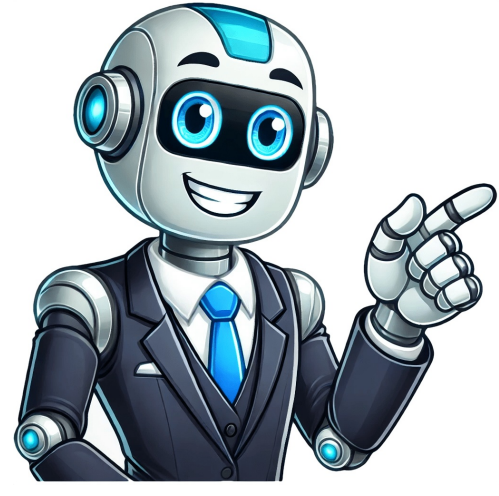

This behemoth surpasses its predecessors, the original Oasis-class vessels Oasis OTS and Allure OTS, with a staggering building cost of \$1.35 billion in 2016.Symphony OTS is the world's largest passenger ship with a gross tonnage of 228,100 tons, outclassing its sister Harmony by over 1,000 GT-tons. The massive vessel boasts 7 distinct neighborhoods: Royal Promenade, Central Park, Boardwalk, Entertainment Zone, Sports Zone, Youth Center complex, and Wellness complex. Symphony has more staterooms than Harmony, including a new "Family Suite" concept featuring a slide and various interactive features. This Oasis-Class ship is also heavier, wider, and can accommodate 100 additional passengers compared to its sister ships. Notably, it surpasses the length of the RMS Titanic by nearly 330 feet and the Eiffel Tower by over 165 feet. Symphony offers an array of activities, including FlowRiders, rock-climbing walls, an ice-skating rink, and the world's largest theater at sea. Its promenades feature robot bartenders serving drinks, a first introduced on Quantum of the Seas. The ship has expanded dining options, with new restaurants like Wonderland Imaginative Cuisine and El Loco Fresh, alongside exclusive areas for Suite passengers including a suite lounge, private restaurant, and full-service Suite Sun Zone. Symphony's staterooms are categorized into 38 types, ranging from Suites to Inside cabins, with the largest being the Royal Loft Suite at 1,530 square feet plus an 850 square foot terrace featuring a Jacuzzi. The vessel has 17 decks, with 16 accessible to passengers and 11 having cabins, including wheelchair-accessible options. Instead, new shows have been announced, including "Away We Go!", a black light puppet show for kids aged 3-11. Another unique offering is the Broadway musical show "Hairspray", an original production that explores humour and commentary on early 1960s race relations.Guests can enjoy complimentary 24-hour Room-Service, internet access, and laundry facilities. The ship also features innovative amenities such as piano stairs in Windjammer Marketplace, where musical notes play and the staircase lights up with each step. For relaxation, passengers can unwind in secluded alcoves with lounge chairs or visit one of several lounges and clubs, including Royal Theater, Studio B Lounge, AquaTheatre, Entertainment Place nightclub, "The Attic" Comedy Club, and Crown Lounge. On Deck 15, three 24-hour vending machines offer select merchandise, including Tech Shop, Splash Store, and Health Essentials Store.Entertainment options include new show productions such as "1977", "Flight - Dare to Dream", "Hairspray", and "HiHo", featuring advanced video projection technology and automation.Symphony of the Seas' inaugural summer season explores Mediterranean destinations, with ports in Barcelona, Palma de Mallorca, Provence, Livorno/Florence-Pisa, Civitavecchia/Rome, and Naples. The ship will also offer 7-night Eastern and Western Caribbean itineraries starting from Miami's Terminal A, "Crown of Miami".Following aerial photo shows an Oasis-class vessel as seen from above. Construction of this vessel started with steel-cutting on February 3, 2015, at STX France shipyard in Saint-Nazaire, France. The keel-laying ceremony took place on October 2, 2016, marking the official start of construction. As a symbol of good luck, coins were placed under the keel block and retrieved after the vessel's completion to be presented to the Captain and crew.The vessel was floated out from drydock at STX shipyard on June 9, 2017, signaling the end of exterior works. The official delivery took place on March 23, 2018, attended by RCI's President and CEO Michael Bayley, RCCL's CEO and Chairman Richard Fain, and STX's General Manager Laurent Castaing.Symphony OTS is notable for being the world's first cruise liner christened by a whole family - PenaVega. The naming ceremony took place on November 15, 2018, in PortMiami.The vessel's powerplant consists of four Wärtsila marine diesel engines and two additional engines, supported by three ABB Azipods for propulsion. In 2021, the ship underwent a month-long drydocking project at Navantia Shipyard in Cadiz, Spain, for routine maintenance works.In 2023, Symphony OTS returned to drydock from March 22 to April 13 for further refurbishments, including hotel and public area refreshes, technical upgrades, minor steel works, underwater hull cleaning and painting. The "Jazz on 4" club was converted into a smoking-free Casino Room.Additionally, RCI celebrated its 50th birthday with a themed cruise on Symphony of the Seas in November 2019, featuring unique programming and special events.Royal Caribbean International's Symphony cruise ship boasts a range of impressive features, including hulls with non-toxic coverings that minimize friction and save fuel.
