The Lord of the Rings Strategy Battle Game: A Comprehensive Rule Set In early 2009, Games Workshop released an expansion to the original game called War of the Ring which allows players to emulate large battles from J.R.R. Tolkien's The Lord of the Rings by streamlining the game system The Lord of the Rings Strategy Battle Game is a popular collectible miniature wargame where players build and customize their armies, similar to Warhammer Fantasy Battle players, by collecting and painting miniatures. Armies can be built up through the purchase of boxed sets or blister packs containing plastic or metal miniatures. Players also often collect miniatures simply because they like the way they look. One popular method of collecting is through Battle Games in Middle-earth, a De Agostini magazine that came with free miniatures and contained detailed hobby guides. This has resulted in a wide variety of miniatures available, including promotional ones such as Cimil on Dead Uruk-hai. However, Games Workshop began to discontinue some metal miniatures to replace them with plastic ones, leading to complaint from fans like the retirement of the Boromir Captain of the White Tower miniature, which was later brought back into production. The Lord of the Rings Strategy Battle Game has several differences from Warhammer, making it unique and more realistic. One popular method of conversion is mixing parts from different models, allowing players to design their own paint schemes and modify their miniatures using bits, putty, and other materials. These conversions are often entered into contests at sponsored tournaments and gaming events. Terrain is a crucial part of the game, with many hobbyists creating their own elaborate set pieces using household items and materials like balsa wood, cardboard, and polystyrene. Dioramas, depicting scenes from the film and books, bring terrain and conversion skills together. However, due to licensing agreements, players cannot combine model parts from different manufacturers for official tournaments or conversion awards. The game has undergone several editions, with the fourth edition being released in September 2005. The fourth edition, The One Rulebook to Rule them All, contains the entire set of rules updated and presented in a single large volume. Previous supplements were re-released in updated form, while a compact Mines of Moria edition contains only the updated rules for what was shown in the films. In February 2012, characteristic profiles from old sourcebooks and White Dwarf were condensed into five new sourcebooks. The evolution of the Lord of the Rings tabletop game has been marked by significant changes over the years, with a notable shift from its heyday during the original trilogy's release to a period of decline and eventual revival. The game's core rule system remained largely unchanged for around a decade before being rebranded following the release of The Hobbit film trilogy. Initially, this new iteration failed to match the success seen during the Lord of the Rings trilogy, resulting in dwindling attention from Games Workshop as profits and interest waned. However, the company unexpectedly announced a revival of the game, leading to a third rebranding that shifted focus away from The Hobbit. This led to a major overhaul, with new rules and profiles for all miniatures being published in two books: Armies of The Lord of the Rings and Armies of The Hobbit. A key factor in this revitalization was the release of a new starter box set based on the Battle of Pelennor Fields from The Return of the King. This move sparked significant interest, with further supplements focusing on scenario gameplay and increased coverage by Games Workshop. Notably, the release of a new edition in 2024 introduced minor gameplay adjustments and new profiles for every character in the game. These add-ons are designed to enhance specific areas where the company's license does not extend, such as The Silmarillion.[28] In recent years, Games Workshop has released several expansion packs, including Legions of Middle-earth, which focuses on army building and thematic gameplay. Warriors are pivotal in armies, comprising characters like Aragorn and Frodo, or unnamed heroes. These warriors form the backbone of each army, with examples including Warriors of Harad, Riders of Rohan, Men of Gondor. Each army must be either good or evil, with only miniatures from that side allowed to participate. ## Worldwide Campaigns Games Workshop initiated the War of the Ring Online Campaign in 2005, a first for their UK-based events. This campaign had over 3000 registered participants and was deemed "a fantastic rollercoaster". A smaller campaign in Canada followed, with the same name but fewer participants. ## Community Involvement The community has played a significant role in organizing sides and creating campaigns. Websites like The Last Alliance and The One-Ring have high-quality content, surpassing that of Games Workshop's official site. These online communities have grown from 3000 forum posts per day to over 5000 members on some platforms. ## Influence on Hobby The community has reacted strongly to Games Workshop's products, with some Tolkien purists choosing to create their own miniatures. This response influenced the company's future releases, such as the Men-at-Arms of Dol Amroth. The hobby and sales have benefited from this interaction. ## Campaigns and Competitions Websites like "The Dark Council" and "Cheeseweb" collaborated on a campaign called "Campaign of LoTRs". This highlights the community's creative efforts in organizing their own events and competitions. =====The Lord of the Rings Terrain Articles provide detailed descriptions and guidelines for creating terrain for Games Workshop's Lord of the Rings Strategy Battle Game. These articles serve as a resource for hobbyists to create immersive and realistic environments for their battles. ===== The concept of Dol Amroth in Middle-earth Strategy Battle Game is a unique and intriguing aspect of the Lord of the Rings universe. As discussed on The Palantir's forums and reflected in Games Workshop publications, Dol Amroth represents an alternative path for Men-at-Arms to follow, distinct from the more traditional Gondorian-style armor.
