## Bookshelves recipe minecraft

This guide explains how to make a bookcase in Minecraft, complete with screenshots and step-by-step instructions. A bookcase in Minecraft is filled with colorful books and serves as one of the many building blocks that can be crafted to maximize enchantments. You can stack bookcases next to or on top of each other to create your own library. To craft a bookcase, you will need to gather materials and follow the recipe. The bookcase is available in various versions of Minecraft, including Java Edition, Pocket Edition, Xbox, and PlayStation. In Creative Mode, you can find a bookcase, but to make one, you will need wood planks and books. You can use any type of wood plank, such as oak or spruce. Then, build nearby bookshelves to unlock more powerful enchantments. Each bookshelf must be exactly two squares away from the table, either on the same level or one higher, and there must be an empty space between the table and the shelf for the effect to work. Set up fifteen bookshelves for the best enchantments, as this will allow you to access the highest-level enchantments. Additionally, place torches between the table and some of the bookshelves to adjust the enchantment level, reducing it by blocking each bookshelf. This can be helpful if you want to save experience points (XP) or make lower-level enchantments. Bookshelves are blocks that can be used with enchanting tables to enhance enchantments. They can generate naturally in village libraries, houses, and certain woodland mansion rooms. Each bookshelf can hold up to three books, which drop when the block is broken. Breaking a bookshelf by hand takes some time, but using an axe speeds up the process. When broken, it drops three books that can be used to rebuild the bookshelf with six wood planks. Enchanting tables placed near bookshelves allow for higher-level enchantments. Bookshelves can also be used as fuel in furnaces or traded with librarian villagers. Primarily, they're used near enchanting tables to gain more enchantments. They can also serve as house decor. This guide will walk you through making a bookshelf in Minecraft. 1. Harvest bookshelves from NPC villages (optional), but keep in mind that doing so might save you some steps later on. Villages and strongholds often have libraries with bookshelves, which you can harvest with an axe to get three books per shelf. If you do this, you can skip down to the last crafting step. Otherwise, continue reading. You can find more information on finding a village in this article. Using a tool with silk touch enchantment allows you to harvest the whole bookshelf instead. 2. Gather sugar cane, which might look like reeds or bamboo. Find these plants growing near water and harvest them with any tool. You'll need nine pieces of sugar cane per bookshelf for this step. 3. Turn the gathered cane into paper by opening your crafting table and placing three pieces of sugar cane in a horizontal row. This will yield three sheets of paper each time, which you can then use to make books. 4. Turn the paper into books by following one of two methods depending on your Minecraft version: PC and console versions require leather obtained from cows, while Minecraft Pocket Edition does not need leather. In both cases, you'll be making 3 books per set of 9 sheets of paper. 5. Combine the crafted books with planks to make a bookshelf by placing three books in the middle row of your crafting table and filling the top and bottom rows with wood planks. You can obtain wood planks by chopping down trees with an axe, and they come in various types that don't all need to be the same. 1. To use your bookshelves for their full potential, start by building an enchantment table using the following recipe: obsidian blocks at the bottom, diamonds in the middle, and a book at the top. 2. Next, place two bookshelves exactly two squares away from the enchantment table to unlock more powerful enchantments. For the enchantments to count as "nearby," the shelves must be on the same level or one higher than the table, with no objects in between. 3. For the highest-level enchantments, you'll need to place 15 bookshelves that meet these criteria for each enchantment table. To create an enchanting table, there are a couple of ways to do so: Firstly, surround the table with a large square of bookshelves, leaving one gap in between for easy access. Alternatively, you can make an L-shape out of eight bookshelves and place another stack on top, creating extra space if needed. It's recommended to have at least 30 levels of experience before starting enchanting, as this will give you the best chance at obtaining strong enchantments. To adjust the level, place torches around the table. Some enchantments are only available at lower levels and may require saving XP by blocking bookshelves, which can reduce the table's enchantment level. To craft a chiseled bookshelf in Minecraft, start by placing wood planks into the survival inventory's crafting table. Once you have converted logs to wooden planks, you can move on to making a crafting table, as explained further in this guide. You'll also need these wooden planks for other projects like building a bookshelf. Keep them handy because they're needed for various tasks. Next, locate sugar cane and leather to create the necessary books. Sugar cane grows near water sources in most biomes and can be identified by its 1-4 block height and ability to thrive on sand or grass. If you plan to make multiple books at once, consider setting up a sugar cane farm to streamline the process. To learn how to craft the required books, refer to our guide for detailed instructions. With your books and wooden planks in hand, proceed to craft your first bookshelf. Begin by placing down your crafting table and opening its GUI. Fill the top and bottom rows of the menu with your chosen wood planks, then fill the remaining middle spaces with the created books. After completing these steps, you can place your bookshelf anywhere within the game world. However, be cautious when breaking a bookshelf, as it will drop three books unless you're using an enchanted tool. Alternatively, you can use wooden slabs made from the same materials. In this example, we're using oak planks and slabs. To create a chiseled bookshelf, follow the exact pattern shown below, placing 3 wood planks in the first row, 3 wooden slabs in the second row, and 3 wood planks in the third row. Once you've placed the correct pattern in the crafting area, the chiseled bookshelf will appear in the box to the right. To move it to your inventory, simply select it and place it in your desired location. Bookshelves are used for various purposes in Minecraft, such as storing enchantment books near an enchanting table or serving as decorative elements in a house. Don't assume all bookshelves need to be identical. To improve enchantment tables, construct a table first and then set up nearby bookshelves for more powerful enchantments. The ideal placement is two squares away from the table, either on the same level or one higher, with no obstructions in between. For optimal results, establish fifteen bookshelves. To achieve this, you can create a large square with gaps or form an L-shape with eight bookshelves and add another layer above it. Aim for 30 levels of experience before enchanting. A level-30 enchantment typically requires only three additional experience points from the user and offers the highest chance at strong enchantments. Adjust the enchantment level by placing torches between the table and some bookshelves. This will reduce the enchantment level, making it easier to save experience points by creating lower-level enchantments.
