## How do i reset my bose wireless speaker

To troubleshoot common issues with your electronic devices, it's essential to know how to reset them. Whether you need to sell an old device or simply resolve connectivity problems, understanding the reset process can save time and frustration. For Bose speakers, a popular brand among music enthusiasts, resetting is a crucial step in resolving various issues. First step is turn off the device and disconnect it from any connected devices. Unplug it for thirty seconds before plugging it back in and waiting another thirty seconds to reconnect. If you want restore factory settings, remove it from voice assistant and Bose accounts first. Then hold Skip Forward button and Power button on remote for about five seconds to reboot. SoundTouch 10 Wireless Speaker needs same steps but with Volume Down button instead of Skip Forward. To reset, turn power off, unplug for thirty seconds, then plug back in. To restore factory settings, just turn on power, hold Volume Down and 1 buttons for ten seconds until you see blinking lights and reboot. Bose TV Speaker only needs unplugging for one minute before plugging it back in. Note that resetting your device is different from restoring factory settings - the first keeps existing data while second erases everything like new box status. When selling used devices, good practice to restore factory settings especially if linked to personal info accounts. Some devices make reset and factory restoration same thing but more complex devices differ significantly. Simple way to fix performance issues or unwanted settings is resetting speaker manually. To disconnect Alexa from Bose speaker, enter app on your phone and remove it as connected device. Same for Google Voice Assistant on Google app. Even need to unlink from Bose Muse Account too. In short, knowing how to reset or restore factory settings really helpful whether you're selling speaker or just trying to fix performance issues. Most Bose speakers can be reset by pressing Play/Pause button for ten seconds until power off and lights flash showing completion. This applies to majority of Bose speakers but not all. On the S1 Pro Plus model, press and hold the Power button for 10 seconds until the power light turns off and a message appears on the channel displays. The system will reboot. When the reset is complete, the power light will glow solid white. Please note that a factory reset on the wireless transmitter removes all pairing information and returns it to original factory settings. On the transmitter, press and hold the Power button for 10 seconds until the power light turns off.
