Kallinge is a small town in Ronneby Municipality, Sweden, with approximately 4,561 residents as of 2010. The town has a strong industrial and military presence, with an air force base (Blekinge Wing) established in 1944. Kallinge also serves as an airport for civil aircraft, known as Ronneby Airport.
