NSCDC Announces 2025 Civil Defence Recruitment Training Details, Candidates Urged to Take Note of Date and Requirements The Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) has yet to fix a date for the 2025 Civil Defence recruitment training exercise but will update this page as soon as the details are announced. Successful candidates must appear at their designated training venues on time, failing to report within the stipulated timeframe results in declining the offer. The training exercise will be held in selected states across the federation. Candidates are required to bring the following documents and items to the training camp: - One white coloured office flat jacket - Two recent passports photographs with name written at the back - Certificate of origin - Educational qualifications - Birth certificate or declaration of age - Duly completed guarantor's form The NSCDC is currently training 5,000 new recruits and for shortlisted candidates, further information can be found on this page. Currently, the corps has begun training 5,000 selected candidates at various locations across the country.
