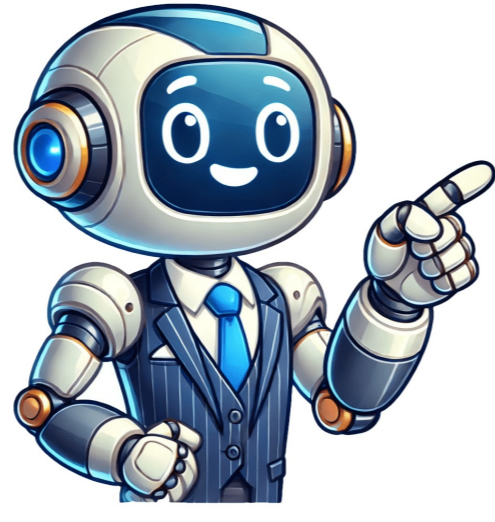

Il Bonus libri 2024/2025: come funziona e a chi spettaSu "Fai domanda" necessario autenticarsi e seguire la procedura. Le famiglie lombarde devono richiedere il Bonus libri entro le ore 12:00 del 15 giugno 2023. In Piemonte, il bonus consiste in un voucher virtuale per l'acquisto di libri e materiali didattici. Gli studenti con residenza in Piemonte e et inferiore ai 21 anni possono richiedere questo contributo. Il requisito per accedere al contributo rispondere a determinate condizioni, come essere iscritti a una scuola statale o paritaria e avere un ISEE non superiore a 26.000 euro. L'importo del voucher varia a seconda dell'ISEE familiare e del grado di iscrizione. Il Bonus libri un programma regionale che fornisce aiuti finanziari alle famiglie con figli frequentanti le scuole secondarie di primo e secondo grado per l'acquisto dei libri di testo. In Emilia Romagna, il contributo varia in base all'ISEE, mentre in Puglia gratuito o semigratuito per le famiglie a basso reddito con ISEE inferiore a 10.632,94 euro. Ecco come richiederlo e quanto costa.### Requisiti per accedere al Bonus libri LazioPer accedere a questo beneficio, gli studenti devono soddisfare alcuni requisiti: * essere iscritti, per l'a.s., a una scuola secondaria di primo o secondo grado statale o paritaria privata; * essere residenti in un Comune della Regione Lazio* avere un'età non superiore a 20 anni* avere un ISEE non superiore a 15.748,78 euro (per i Comuni di Capraia Isola e Isola del Giglio la soglia ISEE di 36.000 euro)Conserving the text for at least 5 years. Umbria has published the Bonus libri 2023/2024 notice, with applications to be submitted to the municipality of residence. To submit an application, families with students must meet certain requirements: reside in one of Umbria's municipalities; enroll their children in a secondary school of first or second grade; have Italian citizenship, EU citizenship, or a long-term residence permit; and have an ISEE income not exceeding 15,493.71 euros. Abruzzo has established the modalities for the Bonus libri Abruzzo, with similar requirements to last year's scheme: resident in one of Abruzzo's municipalities; have a child enrolled in secondary school of first or second grade; have an ISEE income not exceeding 15,493.71 euros; and not have already received other public subsidies for purchasing textbooks. Each municipality manages the Bonus libri Abruzzo. Important: Applications for reimbursement of book expenses must be submitted to the applicant's municipality of residence, which may have different modalities (mail or paper form). Marche introduced a Bonus libri for students of middle or higher education from families with an ISEE income not exceeding 10,632.94 euros. Applications could be submitted to the applicant's municipality of residence, as the initiative was managed at the municipal level. Basilicata has not yet published the Bonus libri 2023/2024 notice, while Molise and Liguria have not yet released the 2024/2025 notice. The Regional Programming for Education Law 23 December 1998, n. 448 establishes a benefit for families to guarantee partial or full reimbursement of expenses incurred for purchasing textbooks for students in middle school and high school. The law excludes elementary schools, which have a different mechanism. The Italian government has introduced a "book bonus" program to help families with school-aged children purchase textbooks. The program is managed by each region and city, and its specific requirements can vary. In 2024, the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR) increased funding for the book bonus, allowing more support for low-income families starting from 2025. The book bonus is a financial contribution or voucher provided to families with children in school, helping them cover the costs of buying textbooks. The program is available to students and their families who are residents of the region where they attend school. The funding is allocated directly by the regional authorities, often through local councils or specific entities responsible for education. The eligibility criteria for the book bonus vary from one region to another. Some programs are open to all students, while others may have more restrictive requirements. Generally, the beneficiaries are families with children enrolled in schools at various levels (middle school, high school, vocational training) and accredited by their respective regions. The program often targets low-income families. In some cases, additional support is provided for families with disabled children, as seen in the Tuscany region's example. To provide more assistance to these families, the Italian Parliament has allocated new funds. The article provides an overview of the book bonus program, including which regions have published their bids, how to apply, and what is required (ISEE level) to receive the reimbursement. **Enrollment and Book Bonus Information** For the academic year 2024-2025, enrollment applications can be submitted from January 1st to March 31st through an online service available on this page. **Regional Book Bonuses** The Sicilian Region has confirmed its book bonus program for the 2024-2025 academic year. The new aspect is that municipalities will now be involved in the management and payment process. Applicants must monitor announcements published on websites and main communication channels used by their municipal residence, and follow rules and instructions to apply for the benefit. **Calabrian Book Bonus** The Calabrian Region offers book bonuses to families with children attending secondary schools and having an ISEE income below a certain threshold. For Calabria, applicants must refer to each municipality, as programs are managed at the local level. The contribution is generally available to families with an ISEE income of up to 6,000. **Abruzzo Book Bonus** The Abruzzo Region has maintained its book bonus program for the 2024-2025 academic year, requiring applicants to be residents in one of Abruzzo's municipalities, have a child enrolled in secondary school, and have an ISEE income not exceeding 15,493.71. The application process is managed by each municipality, which may have different procedures (email or paper form). **Expired or Upcoming Book Bonus Programs** As of now, the book bonus programs for the Lombardy, Sardinia, Basilicata, Liguria, Trentino-Alto Adige, Emilia-Romagna, Marche, Campania, Tuscany, Puglia, Veneto, Umbria, Lazio, and Friuli-Venezia Giulia regions are no longer active or have expired. New programs will be available from January onward.
