You can download and watch TV shows and movies from the Netflix app at any time, even without an internet connection. To do this, you need a device with the latest version of the Netflix app installed. Make sure your device is updated to avoid compatibility issues. To find and download content, open the Netflix app and look for the Downloads icon or filter by available titles. Select a TV show or movie you want to download, then tap Download on your iPhone, iPad, Android, or Fire devices, or click Downloads > Find More to Download on Chromebooks. You can have up to 100 active downloads per device at any given time, depending on your Netflix plan. To watch downloaded content offline, open the Netflix app, select Downloads, and find the title you want to play. Note that downloaded content may expire after a certain period or have limits on how many times they can be downloaded. Unfortunately, there is no official Netflix app for Macs, and using unofficial workarounds can pose risks to your device's security. However, you can download Netflix shows using some of these workarounds, but be cautious of websites that claim to offer downloads and may install malware on your Mac. You cannot use AirPlay to stream Netflix from an iOS device to a Mac since Netflix discontinued this feature in April 2019. To watch Netflix videos offline on your Mac, we recommend using PlayCover, an open-source project that allows you to run any iOS app or game on Apple Silicon Macs with mouse, keyboard, and controller support. Although Apple Silicon Macs can run iOS apps via the Mac App Store, this doesn't work for Netflix as the developer has blocked it. To use PlayCover, download a decrypted IPA file for the Netflix iOS app from third-party sites like Decrypt or ARM Converter, then drag and drop the file into PlayCover to add it to your library. You can then double-click on the Netflix app to start using it on your Mac. Note that the app will only appear in your PlayCover App Library, not in your Mac's Applications folder. Additionally, you can use PlayCover to run other iOS apps not available for Mac, such as Instagram (if you find a decrypted IPA file). Boot Camp is a free method to watch videos offline on Intel Macs. However, it's not compatible with Apple Silicon Macs, making it unusable for M-chip Macs. For Apple Silicon Macs, using Parallels to install Windows and then installing the Netflix app is the best option. But this method won't allow you to watch content offline on your Mac, and downloading content will result in an "error code U7354" due to technical limitations. Setting up Boot Camp or Parallels can be time-consuming, and both methods have their drawbacks. Another option is using a screen recorder to capture Netflix shows and movies. However, this method has several issues - it's against Netflix's terms of service, results in poor video quality, takes up valuable space on your Mac hard drive, and you can't use your Mac for other tasks while recording. A better approach is to use QuickTime to record your entire screen, which is free and available on all macOS versions. However, by default, it only records sounds from your Mac's internal microphone and not the audio coming from Netflix. To fix this, you need to install an additional plugin to record the internal Netflix sound. First, make sure you have an iOS device connected to your Mac via cable. Go to Settings > General > About on your iOS device to check if it's running iOS 13 or higher. Open the Netflix app and look for the download icon in each show's description. If the title is available for download, you can save up to 100 shows at once. Connect your iPhone or iPad to your Mac using a Lightning cable. On your Mac, open QuickTime Player and select File > New Movie Recording. Choose the connected iPhone or iPad as the camera. This will allow you to access your iOS device's home screen, where you can open the Netflix app and watch downloaded shows offline. For watching Netflix in another country, use a VPN like NordVPN, which also speeds up your internet connection. Unfortunately, there is no direct way to download Netflix shows on a MacBook through macOS. However, if you have an Intel-based Mac, you can connect your iOS device via cable and access the downloads. But for M2 Apple silicon MacBooks, follow these workarounds: 1. Install Parallels Desktop on your Mac to create a virtual machine. 2. Download Windows 11 and install it using the Parallels Desktop wizard. 3. Log in with your Microsoft account and download Netflix from the Microsoft Store within the Windows environment. This allows you to save shows offline, although this method is more convoluted than others. To download Netflix content on a MacBook, iMac, or Mac mini, you must log in with your credentials on the Netflix website, but there's no direct app for macOS. A possible solution is using an Intel-based Mac with Boot Camp, which allows Windows installation and subsequently enables Netflix offline viewing through its app. Alternatively, users can utilize AirPlay by streaming from an iPhone or iPad with downloaded content, though this requires a third-party app like Fast Cast and Wi-Fi connection on both devices. Another option involves installing Windows on your Mac, providing full access to Windows 11 features, including Netflix offline viewing, for a one-time payment of \$99 through Parallels. Be cautious of suspicious apps claiming to offer Netflix downloads, as they often contain malware; only trust official Netflix sources. Here are some workarounds to watch Netflix content offline on your Mac: you can run Windows on your Mac if you're unsure about how to do it, check out our article for more info. Alternatively, use Screen Record to capture and save content while streaming, allowing you to view the recording later without an internet connection - however, this is not recommended due to piracy concerns. While there's no straightforward way to download Netflix movies or TV shows directly on a Mac, some methods exist as workarounds. Unfortunately, most are too complicated or inconvenient for practical use. For now, it's best to stream content via the official Netflix website online or watch offline on other devices except your Mac. To install the Netflix app on your Mac using PlayCover: 1. Download the PlayCover installer from their official site; note that this only works with Apple Silicon-powered Macs. 2. Install PlayCover by dragging its app into your Applications folder. 3. Launch PlayCover, then download a decrypted IPA file for the Netflix iOS app (available through Decrypt IPA Store or ARM Converter). 4. Drag the Netflix IPA file into the PlayCover window to install it; the app will automatically extract and install Netflix on your Mac. 5. Once done, double-click the Netflix icon to launch the app and access your profiles. Note: The Netflix app won't appear in your Applications folder; instead, you must first launch PlayCover to access the app seamlessly. For non-Apple Silicon hardware, simply open the Netflix website using a browser like Safari or Google Chrome. Keep in mind that while PlayCover is considered safe, be cautious when downloading and installing apps from third-party sources, ensuring to only download it from their official site.
