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Born Haruno Shiobana, Giorno is the son of Dio (fathered using Jonathan Joestar's body, which makes him part of the Joestar family) and a Japanese woman. As a young child, his mother married to an Italian man, and they moved to Italy; hence, Haruno Shiobana became Giorno Giovanna. Giorno's great ambition in life is to become a mafia boss (a "Gang Star"), and as such, he eventually joins the mob squad Passione. Though he is its youngest and newest member, he quickly proves his mettle and eventually becomes the de facto leader of the group. Unlike typical mafia bosses, he wanted to give divested riches to the poor, giving him an agenda similar to Robin Hood. He eventually inherits all of Passione's wealth from his boss, who later became the worst enemy on Earth, Kenschō Japanese Reich, Phillip English Kawaye, Janzi English Dardot, Estelle French Maurille, Marc French Piedra, Jos French Pineda, Jos French Pineda, Spanish Fujikura, Natsumi Japanese Fagundes, Vagner Portuguese (BR) Augusto, Agrie Portuguese (BR) Garcia Llop, David Spanish Baeher, Patrick German A detailed chronological summary of the life of Giorno Giovanna. BackgroundHaruno Shiobana was born on April 16, 1985 as the son of DIO (fathered using Jonathan Joestar's body) and a Japanese woman. Haruno's first years were marked by his mother's neglect. Since she viewed him as a threat to her party life, he would be left alone at night on several occasions, where he would be too scared to even cry.When he turned four, his mother married an Italian man and they moved to Italy, resulting in Haruno having his name changed to "Giorno Giovanna". His new stepfather, however, would often beat him for always trying to read others when his mother was not around, even though it was that same physical abuse that brought about Giorno's habit. That, coupled with the fact that Giorno easily became the target of bullies, gave him very low self-esteem, to the point of believing himself to be scum and setting him on the path to becoming twisted and immoral.[1]From broken child to driven teenHowever, one day as Giorno was walking home, he came upon a man covered in blood lying in a patch of tall grass. After discovering the injured man, other men approached Giorno, asking him if he knew where the man had gone. Giorno lied to them, feeling that the injured man was the same as him, and subconsciously activated his Stand's ability to mask the man's presence by causing the grass to grow taller and bloom flora. Around two months later, the man showed himself to Giorno again and told him that he would never forget what he did for him. Things soon turned brighter for Giorno: his stepfather stopped hitting him and he became popular among kids his own age. It turned out that the man was a gangster who quietly watched over Giorno from the shadows. To Giorno, this was the first time someone else had treated him like a human being and showed him respect. The trust that Giorno should have learned from his father was instead taught to him by others, and ever since, he has been described as a "cool breeze" blowing inside his heart, marking his change from a cold and amoral child to a charming and righteous person who subsequently forged a path to make the corrupt Italian mafia a better and fairer place, and eventually created a "Gang-Star"[1]A few months before Vento Aureo, Giorno discovers his Stand's ability.[2] Vento AureoOn March 29, 2001, Giorno is 15 years old and operates as a petty scammer at the Naples airport. The anime adaptation expands on his day. Giorno is shown helping two tourists find the way to Santa Chiara Church; when a pickpocket steals one of the tourists' wallet, Giorno steals it back and returns it to her. However, he turns two bank notes into butterflies that go to him. With this money, Giorno buys himself a chocolate-pistachio ice cream for him and another boy.Meeting Koichi HiroseGiorno meets Koichi HiroseKoichi Hirose meets Giorno while he's showing off a trick to the guards of Naples Airport in which he stuffs his entire ear into his ear canal. Giorno amuses the guards and bribes them in order to operate there at the day. Seeing Koichi, Giorno offers him ride as an illegal taxi for 10,000 liras or a mere 500 yen. Koichi is suspicious but sees the long waiting line for legitimate taxis and accepts Giorno's offer. Giorno asks Koichi to put his luggage in the front seat himself and drives away after Koichi obliiges. Koichi uses Echoes's 3 Freeze to increase the weight of the tires. Giorno gives Koichi a sly smile and runs away, after using his Stand's power to turn Koichi's luggage into a frog.Encounter with Leaky-Eye LucaLuca tries to brutalize GiornoGiorno then has an encounter with Leaky-Eye Luca, who demands protection money from him. Giorno claims to not have any, but Luca, who is unconvinced, takes Giorno's wallet and reveals a picture of DIO. Luca becomes increasingly violent while Giorno insists that he has no money. Suddenly the frog born from Koichi's luggage returns and begins climbing up Giorno's pants. Upon seeing the frog, Luca orders him to kill it, but Giorno refuses, claiming it to not have anything to do with their situation. The refusal enrages Luca, who attempts to smash both the frog and Giorno with his shovel, but the side effects of his Stand ability manifest and cause the attack to rebound upon and kill him. Still frustrated by Luca's stupidity, Giorno leaves the scene.[3]Giorno then spends the night staying at the home of Polpo, snatching his passport and forcing him to flee. He eventually reveals his Stand, Gold Experience. Gold Experience turns the pavement into a tree lying in wait for the grumpy When Koichi sends Echoes to attack for the 24 hours order to increase affects Koichi, Giorno compliments Koichi for being merciful enough to not attack with the intent to kill, nonetheless, Giorno escapes once again.[4]Battle Against Bruno BucciaratiBruno Bucciarati is sent to avenge LucaSoon, problems arise for Giorno as news of Luca's death spreads, and Bruno Bucciarati visits him on the funicular to interrogate him. Bucciarati reveals that Luca was part of a gang and his boss sent him to investigate the death and avenge the affront the culprit committed against the boss's reputation. Bucciarati asks Giorno if he saw Luca at the airport and Giorno lies, pretending to have never heard of him. Bucciarati seems satisfied and leaves, but Giorno suddenly finds Luca's eye in his closed fist. Unnerved, Giorno sweats, which allows a returning Bucciarati to lick him and realize that he's lying.Bucciarati reenters the funicular and the gangster soon openly strikes Giorno and causing zippers to appear on his body. After one punch too many, Giorno summons Gold Experience to deflect Bucciarati's strikes and thus out himself as the culprit. Gold Experience punches Bucciarati in the chest, sending him flying. It is then that Giorno realizes that infusing life into living people makes their spirits go haywire, accelerating their thought processes but leaving the body immobile. With Giorno's opponent temporarily defenseless, Gold Experience uses the opportunity to land a solid punch to Bucciarati's face, applying enough strength to break a tree. Giorno attacks again but Bucciarati fully reveals his own Stand, Sticky Fingers. Sticky Finger blocks Gold Experience's attack but Bucciarati prefers to make a strategic retreat. Opening the walls of the funicular with his zippers, Bucciarati gets out of the funicular. Giorno gives chase as he cannot let the gangster alert his whole gang and turn the affair into an unwinnable battle. Giorno injures himself to defeat Bucciarati. Giorno catches up to Bucciarati in an alley but the gangster collides with a group of bystander, hiding in one of them. To find him, Giorno transforms Bucciarati's tooth into a fly, allowing him to travel and locate him. Giorno then attacks Bucciarati by grabbing his shadow, forcingly pulls out the eye, and then Bucciarati is pressured into drinking a cup of "tea" which is actually Abbacchio's urine, the group see him hesitate and begin to mock him. However, Giorno earns the team's proper attention and awe by traveling past said arm. Giorno is then attacked by Sticky Fingers and has various body parts unzipped, leaving him disabled and near-defenseless. As Bucciarati moves in to finish his job, Giorno tips his own arm at the zipper in order to get a decisive punch in first, leaving Bucciarati unable to act yet again. Giorno is thus free to approach Bucciarati.However, instead of attacking Bucciarati, Giorno walks past him and tends to the unconscious teenager. When Bucciarati questions him why, Giorno explains that he had noticed Bucciarati briefly glancing with shame at the drug-injected arm of the teenager during the fight. Giorno correctly deduced that, like Koichi, Bucciarati is a good person, and acknowledges that the gangster won't attack him anymore, something Bucciarati indeed follows through with. The two develop a mutual respect, and Giorno boldly reveals his dream to become a "Gang-Star" who will take over the Neapolitan mafia in order to defend the innocent. Moreover, Polpo's cell is quite luxurious, complete with a fridge, a collection of firearms, and some paintings. When questioned about what the most important quality in a person is, Giorno initially tells him that the most important quality is honesty, but he is actually telling the truth. The two develop a mutual respect, and Giorno boldly reveals his dream to become a "Gang-Star" who will take over the Neapolitan mafia in order to defend the innocent. However, Bucciarati warns him that at the first mistake, Bucciarati will not support his infiltration. 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[25] Giorno and Bucciarati both love Passion to protect her, and are soon joined by the rest of the team of the team minus Fugo.[26][27]After fighting against Passion's elite team and finding a likeness of the boss's face at the cost of Abbacchio's life,[28][27][29][30] the team reaches the Colosseum to find the informant that could reveal the identity of the boss.[31] Giorno and the rest find themselves swapped in each other's bodies, with Giorno residing in Narancia's.[32] They meet the informant, Jean Pierre Polnareff, who explains them how the team can awaken their boss, since revealed to be Diavolo, and how his own awakened Stand, Silver Chariot Requiem, has the sole purpose of safekeeping the Arrow and was responsible for the body swap.[33][34] After Narancia is killed by Diavolo, Giorno goes back to his original body.[35] Attempting to take the Stand Arrow to provide an advantage against Diavolo, the team finds out that he is residing alongside Trish in Mista's body.[36] As everyone else goes back into their bodies, Bucciarati says his final goodbyes to Giorno and the latter gains the Arrow.[37] Awakening his Stand to Gold Experience Requiem (, Grudo Eklusuperiensu Rekiuem),[b][38] Giorno kills and punishes Diavolo by forcing him to live through an endless loop of various deaths.[39] After Diavolo's defeat, Giorno installs himself as the boss of Passione, with Mista and Polnareff by his side.[40]Giorno appears as a playable character of the following related games: GioGio's Bizarre Adventure,[41] JoJo's Bizarre Adventure: All-Star Battle,[7] it's remake JoJo's Bizarre Adventure: All-Star Battle R,[42] JoJo's Bizarre Adventure: Eyes of Heaven,[8] and JoJo's Bizarre Adventure: Last Survivor.[43] Giorno is also playable in Jump Force as DLC[44] and Puzzle & Dragons in collaborations of the anime and the game's 10th anniversaries from December 26, 2022 to January 9, 2023.[45][46]Some critics praised Giorno's ties to both Dio and the Joestar family and his sense of justice despite the vicious side of his personality. Steven Blackburn of Screen Rant praises Golden Wind for making the decision of Giorno of being Dio's son with Joestar blood, as it presents an interesting narrative and how it is in conflict with the Joesters in the early chapters. The reviewer also highlights how Giorno is the only son of Dio's that has an entire part centered around him and that his heroism "serves as a stunning rebuke of Dio's legacy".[47] Jordan Richards of AIPT Comics considers Giorno to be interesting and compelling due to his relation with Dio, his abusive childhood, and how his life-changing of saving a mafia member changes him. The reviewer also notes that while his introduction made him come off as a jerk, his attitude when protecting innocents shows his nobility and appreciates him to be different from the past protagonists.[48] Jenni Lada of Siliconera lauds the first volume of how Giorno is being investigated by Jotaro Kujo and Koichi Hirose provides an interesting premise and that his childhood and heroic, yet criminal qualities make him worth rooting for.[49] Spencer Legacy of Noisy Pixel appreciates how in comparison of Golden Wind 's past fan translations, the official English-translated manga makes him feel more authentic and how he is "much more passionate and memorable here, making him a character worth following".[50] Natasha H. of IGN considers Giorno to be the heart and soul of the story, thinking that he has the best traits of each previous Joestar and him being the son of Dio provides a great contrast. The reviewer also feels that his honorable yet quick-thinking deceitfulness makes him interesting compared to the previous protagonists.[51] Jennifer Sherman of Manga Tokyo praises Kensho Ono's portrayal of Giorno for being powerful and youthful and providing a sense of brightness to the character that none of his previous voice actors the reviewer feels they achieve.[52]Other critics dislike Giorno's characterization, specifically as Golden Wind reaches its finale. Sam Leach of Anime News Network feels that Giorno isn't deserving of his new position as the boss of Passione as the reviewer wants the character to show a little more charisma, resulting in the reviewer believing that it doesn't hold as much importance as Diavolo's defeat. Moreover, the reviewer felt that in comparison to the characters seen in the part who feel more engaging, Giorno doesn't hold the same emotional attachment and how his and Diavolo's "legendary battle between obvious good and obvious evil isn't developed enough to serve as a counterbalance to the rest of the cast".[53] Sakaki of Toonami Faithful feels Giorno is a "Jo-bro" of his own part, as the reviewer finds the other characters to be more interesting than him.[54] Reverse Thieves sees Giorno as boring that the reviewer feels Bucciarati is more of a protagonist, citing that Giorno barely gets the time to shine in spite of his backstory, appearance, and ambitions, how he ends up falling flat as a character, and feeling like a plot device providing more as an observer. The reviewer also criticizes his Stand for being complicated whose abilities don't unify as a single power in comparison to Star Platinum and Crazy Diamond's being straightforward and Araki not utilizing some of the cited power-ups.[55] Surreal Resolution thinks that Giorno's characterization doesn't feel realized, with his familial baggage not being touched upon throughout the story and how wasted it is that Polnareff couldn't provide any insight on the character due to their connection with Dio.[56]Critics praised the beatdown against Cioccolata which is seen as a famous and anticipated fight amongst the fandom.[57][58][59] Jennifer Sherman also commends Kensho Ono's depiction of Giorno during the scene, calling it amazing that they find the rest of the episode to be a blur.[57] Sam Leach finds it to be one of Giorno's most satisfying victories.[60] David King of Bubbleblabber finds the beatdown to be satisfying in spite of the length in the anime.[59] Katherine Simon of The Ball State Daily believed that David Production delivered the scene, due to its animation of the barrages and Kensho Ono's screams.
