Bay Academy offers strong academics, various extracurricular activities, and a sense of community to its students. Some families consider it a suitable school due to its relatively low stress levels compared to other selective middle schools in Brooklyn. Students are selected based on their performance in one of ten different talents, such as sports, science, and art. Although many entering sixth-graders have excellent test scores, Bay Academy also caters to students with varying academic abilities. The school groups children by talent from the start, using a summer assignment and test scores to determine placement in English, math, and seventh-grade science classes. While students from different classes interact during these subjects, they also come together in their respective talents and social studies classes as well as at lunch. All sixth- and seventh-graders participate in double periods of English and math. Those who meet the school's criteria may take Algebra and Living Environment Regents exams in eighth grade. Most students who take these tests pass. Instead of a modern foreign language, all students learn Latin as part of the English language arts curriculum. This program is particularly beneficial for Bay Academy students, many of whom are not native English speakers. The principal, Marie Timo, believes that teaching Latin helps students understand English better. Students must remain in their designated talent throughout their time at Bay Academy, but the school provides opportunities for them to explore other talents as well. The school offers a popular after-school program and various activities, including a student newspaper and an engineering club specifically for girls. Bay Academy also supports its students through after-school tutoring, morning sessions, and a variety of charity fundraising events. The school has two full-time guidance counselors and a social worker on staff. Students can arrive as early as 6:30 am to prepare or watch news and sports on television before classes begin. The principal, Marie Timo, has made efforts to improve the facility by upgrading the lighting, installing new computers and tablets in the library, and creating a new dance studio. The school also plans to renovate its courtyard and greenhouse in the future. A security system is in place to monitor students during lunch and bathroom times. Bay Academy uses an integrated approach for special education, where students with disabilities are taught alongside general education students through team-teaching classes. Many students who initially require additional support no longer need assistance by the time they graduate from the school. Admission to Bay Academy requires students to live in District 21 or a nearby area defined by the Department of Education. Applicants must take the district talent test in two areas of their choosing. Bay, Brooklyn, The Bay Academy - I.S. 98 offers strong academics, many extracurricular activities and a community spirit. Some families see it as a good school that is not as stressful as some of the other screened or audition middle schools in Brooklyn. Students are selected on the basis of their performance in one of 10 different talents, including athletics, science and math, as well as the arts. Only students that reside within District 21 or attend a District 21 Elementary School are eligible to be accepted to The Bay Academy. Students must remain in their talent for their entire Bay career but the school provides opportunities for students to try their hand at other talents as well. The school has a popular afterschool program and a variety of activities including a student newspaper, sports talk show, coding club and many others. The school's Science Olympiad team, which has done well in statewide competitions is also being held virtually. Students also participate in arts, poetry and literature contests. The school takes part in a number of charity fund-raising events to promote civic engagement and community service.
