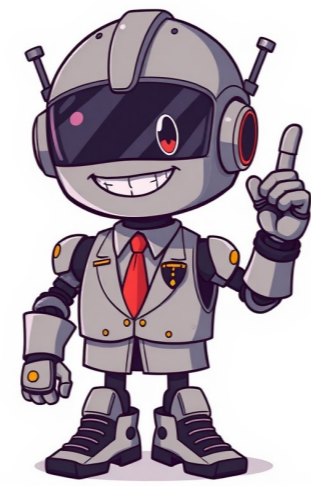

Baybayin Neue Design Approach ----- Unlike other baybayin fonts, this typeface takes an utilitarian approach rather than a decorative one. It was inspired by Swiss-German pioneers of type design and is paired well with most International Typographic Style font families (ITS). This makes it practical for use in bilingual settings. Why it's useful ----- The Baybayin script can be tricky to write, so having this font that pairs well with the Latin alphabet will make it easier for people to use. It's like a Swiss Army knife of baybayin typefaces. Who can use Baybayin Neue? ----- This font is open source, which means anyone who downloads it and has the license .txt file can use it for free. In Canva's superfamily of condensed fonts, Paalalabas stands out as a unique and versatile display serif typeface with organic features. Its straightforward and compact style makes it perfect for informative materials, reports, and any design need that requires clarity and efficiency. On the other hand, Zenaída is a more decorative and ornate font that boasts intricate details inspired by Filipino flora and fauna, or traditional art. This font would be suitable for special occasions, titles, and anywhere where a touch of elegance and cultural richness is desired. Meanwhile, Baybayin, an ancient Philippine script dating back to the early 1500s, has been recreated as a new font called Niwang Uno. The name "Niwang" means "thin" or "payat" in Bisaya and Tagalog, referring to the thin brush strokes used to create it. Initially drawn in Adobe Illustrator in 2019, the characters were later refined using Glyphs Mini software during a 30-day free trial. Niwang Uno is an abugida, unlike the English alphabet which uses consonants and vowels separately. Baybayin uses syllables and single vowels, with consonant-vowel syllables making up most of its characters. The font's unique features include the ability to mark vowel sounds by adding a kudlit above or below the character. The traditional Filipino alphabet is also pronounced in a similar way as Baybayin. With Niwang Uno, users can now explore and appreciate this ancient script in a new digital format. The baybayin characters with kudlits are part of a total of 45 characters in the abugida. All 45 characters represent consonant-vowel syllables, except for lone vowels such as A, O/U, I/E, which have their own specific baybayin characters. Gumamela ka dito sa akin kaya GUMAMELA KO. Basta mapagpatuloy ang trabaho mo, at magsisubok ka na maging expert sa baybayin. ===== I notice that when using Baybayin Niwang Uno font, the line spacing appears too large. I suspect this issue might be caused by the font size being set too small in the Glyphs Mini software. As a result, I see significant gaps between lines. To address this problem, I adjust the line spacing in both iOS Pages app and Microsoft Word. In the Pages app, I change the default line spacing to "1" and tweak it according to the font size until it looks more balanced. Similarly, in Microsoft Word, I access Line Spacing Options under Home > Line and Paragraph Spacing and select suitable options from the Spacing dropdown menu. I intend to update the Baybayin Niwang Uno font in the future with a new version that eliminates the need for manual line spacing adjustments. However, for now, I will rely on these workarounds until I acquire the full Glyphs Mini software. I appreciate Gayle's comment about this issue and thank her for bringing it to my attention. As an added bonus, I utilize this font in my Filipino Food Art Etsy shop for printables, which also appeals to Baybayin enthusiasts and food lovers alike.
